Hidradenitis & Me is a support group for those who suffer from Hidradenitis Suppurativa.

Hidradenitis Suppurativa (HS) is a chronic systemic autoimmune skin disease that is not curable but manageable. HS is characterized by expanding tender lumps in the folds of the skin, generally in the armpits and groin area, however they may also appear under the breasts, on the buttocks and inner thighs where the skin rubs together. Painful skin lesions, nodules, and boils can appear in these inflamed areas, usually where apocrine sweat glands are located. Pus drainage occurs when skin of the lump/flare breaks open. Lumps that are close together can bond together under the skin.

It is estimated that over 1 million Canadians are currently living with HS, however the exact number is not known as HS is often misdiagnosed and many who are living with HS don't seek out a dermatologist for help.

Causes

The exact cause of HS is not known. Multiple genetic and environmental factors appear to play a role. The onset around puberty suggests that hormones contribute to disease process probably through plugging of hair follicles where the apocrine sweat glands are located.

Stages of HS

Hurley stage 1: single lump with no sinus tract

Hurley stage 2: more than one lump with tunneling

Hurley stage 3: multiple lumps with sinus tracts,

tunneling, scarring, larger area of

body is affected by lumps

Treatment and Care

- antibiotics
- laser
- biologics
- surgery
- weight loss can decrease the amount of flares that reoccur
